

Privacy policy

1. The security and protection of your personal information

1.1. The security and protection of your personal information is of utmost importance to Indigo DMA Corp., and the company ensures that information of every client working with us is secured. The company does not use personal information for any marketing or commercial purpose.

1.2. The company requests your personal information to confirm your identity and eligibility to trade certain amount of assets, process your orders, transactions and other requests, your creditworthiness, and to provide you with information about our special offers.

1.3. The information that the company collects and maintains includes information that a client provided directly by completing account application at the time he opened account or updating his details later on (name and address, phone and email address, date of birth and other identification information). The company requests a scanned copy of government-issued identification such as a passport, driver's license or state-issued ID to verify client's identity. The company can verify your identity by obtaining information about you from public sources or third parties as well.

1.4. Once a client starts using our services the company will record and maintain information about client's orders and transactions, requests and communications with us, so that the company will be able to provide a client with high-quality service.

2. Affiliated companies.

2.1. The given privacy policy regulates all affiliated companies of Indigo DMA Corp. This concerns a framework control system, processes and procedures designed to effective protection of confidentiality and security of personal information.

2.2. The key characteristic of the term Affiliated Companies, applicable to this privacy policy is common control, whether through ownership, agreement or otherwise. We disclose personal information to affiliated companies so that they could provide a client with requested services, resolve support tickets, improve the services of the company and affiliates, or to provide you with information about our new products and services.

2.3. Our affiliated companies share the same commitment to privacy and will not disclose, sell, share or otherwise distribute your personal information for any marketing or commercial purpose.

3. Non-affiliated companies

3.1. We do not disclose your personal information to third parties except when it is necessary to facilitate your orders or it is required by law. For example, we could disclose limited information to an exchange, a clearing house, or a liquidity provider for the purpose of facilitating client's order.

4. Access to personal information

4.1. The company limit employees' access to information they need to know to perform their duties. All the employees are trained and qualified, and acknowledge privacy policy.

5. Secuity of personal information

5.1. To protect personal information the company uses security software, internal control, and integrated systems, processes and procedures aimed at protection of confidentiality. We also use electronic and physical systems to prevent any unauthorized access to your personal information.

6. Website use and web cookies

6.1. Web cookie is a small piece of data sent to a web browser by a website to help identify the user, facilitate browsing experience, enable and improve your interaction with the website and your dashboard. Such use of web cookies is a commonplace industry standard that represents a secure and effective methodology.

6.2. When a client uses the company's website or logs in, we may also record your IP address and create a personal record of his visit and his interaction with the site so that to improve the quality of the company's services.
